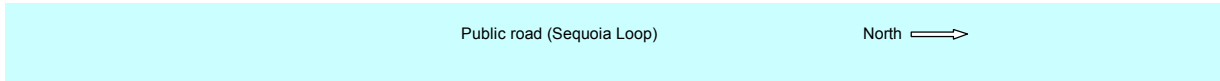


Bowman's Grove Cemetery, Shelby County, Iowa

"The above plat of Bowman's Grove Cemetery is located on land described as follows, to wit:
 "Commencing at a point thirty-seven rods North of the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter
 of Section 12 in Township Seventy-nine North Range Thirty-eight West of 5 PM, Shelby County, Iowa.
 Running thence North one hundred and thirty-four feet and 66/100 of a foot.
 Thence East three hundred and twelve feet and 20/100 of a foot.
 Thence South three hundred and fifty-eight feet and four inches.
 Thence West three hundred and twelve feet and 20/100 of a foot to the West line of said forty acres above mentioned.
 Thence North along the West line of said forty to the place beginning. Except church lot as shown on plat."
