DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

There are two types of dissolution of marriage: 1. Contested; 2. Uncontested. "Uncontested" means that the parties are in agreement as to all issues associated with the marriage. These issues generally are spousal support, child support, child care, division of property, and division of debts. If there is a disagreement as to any issue, then the matter is considered to be "contested". If there are minor children, both parties will need to attend parenting classes and file a certificate of completion with the Court. Information about available providers can usually be obtained from the Court Clerk's website. Each party will have to provide financial affidavits and copies of tax returns, pay stubs, ownership interests, and other required mandatory disclosure. This office does not handle the tax aspects of your dissolution of marriage. Since a dissolution of marriage may significantly affect you and your spouse's tax situation, you should contact a tax attorney or a certified public accountant if you have questions in this regard.
